

EEOC Delays Collecting 2019 EEO-1 Data Due To Coronavirus

The Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC) announced on May 7th the delay of collection of 2019 EEO-1 Component Data until 2021 due to the coronavirus disease. The EEOC expects to collect the 2019 EEO-1 and 2020 EEO-1 data in March 2021. The EEOC will notify entities of the exact date the surveys are open.

As a reminder under federal law, private employers with 100 or more employees and federal contractors with at least 50 employees and a contract of \$50,000 or more with the federal government generally must file the EEO-1 report annually.
